SECTION A – HEARING MATTERS:

A-1 WITHDRAWAL OF APPEALS

1. BOR DKT. 00302556 (P.D.)

Claimant appealed a decision of the Appeal Tribunal holding the claimant liable for a non-fraud refund.

2. BOR DKT. 00357363 (E.G.)

Employer appealed a decision of the Appeal Tribunal holding no disqualification of benefits for leaving work voluntarily, no disqualification of benefits for discharge for misconduct for misconduct, and no liability for a non-fraud refund.
